## We start collecting Lithium primary battery from June 24,2022

In addition to alkaline batteries and manganese batteries that have been collected as harmful waste (batteries), we will also collect lithium primary batteries from June 24,2022.


Put it in a clear bag and put it out in the same way as alkaline batteries and manganese batteries. When disposing of the battery, attach cellophane tape(scotch clear tape) to the electrodes to insulate it.

\*Do not use any tape other than cellophane tape(scotch clear tape). In addition to being unable to read the characters on the battery, it may cause a machine failure during processing.

Lithium primary batteries are marked CR, BR, FR.
